Hertfordshire Schools' SEND Benchmark & Planning Tool Update

Hertfordshire's preferred framework for discussion about policy and provision for children and young people with SEND is the Benchmark & Planning Tool. This approach takes in to account national guidance reflected through Hertfordshire's SEND Strategy. Introduced in 2017, schools should have been using this self-evaluation tool annually to reflect on their own practice and plan next steps. DSPL3 introduced a simple Survey Monkey form that SENCOs could submit their summary data on, so that DSPL3 has an overall picture of strengths and areas for development in our schools that helps us to plan future training and support for schools. **Hertfordshire expected all schools to complete the SEND Benchmark self evaluation and submit the updated data on our online Survey Monkey form by the end of September**
